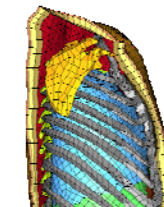
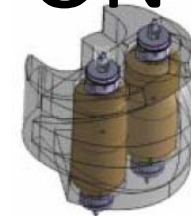
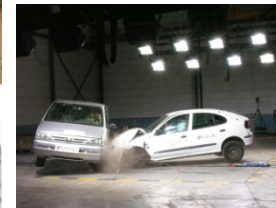
- Two other options:

 - Our story is about children but it is not a fairy tail,



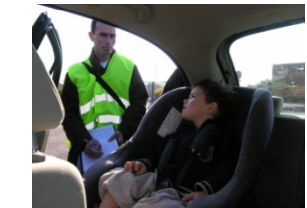
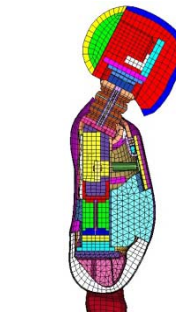
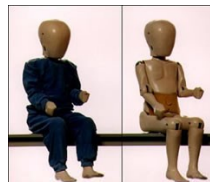

Motivation

A significant reduction of injuries and fatalities of children represents a major social and economic benefit for the whole European Community,

Objectives

Analysis of the reasons and consequences of the conditions of transportation of children both on scientific and sociological aspects. (CRS use, misuse, seating stature as compared to the certification test procedures)

Improvement of the efficiency of child protection

(development of innovative tools: sensors, dummies models, child human models, completed by test procedures, including injury criteria)

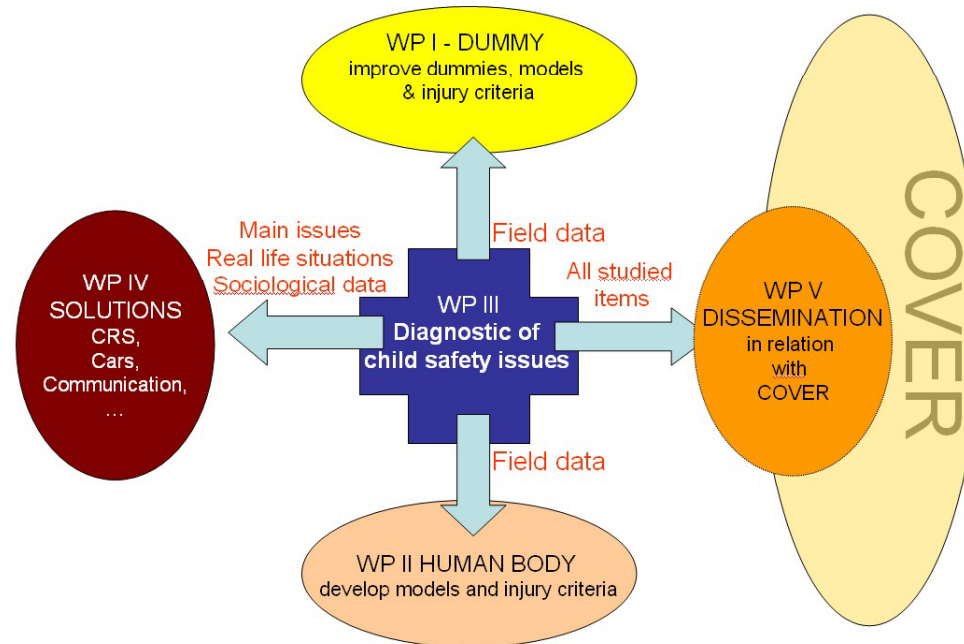

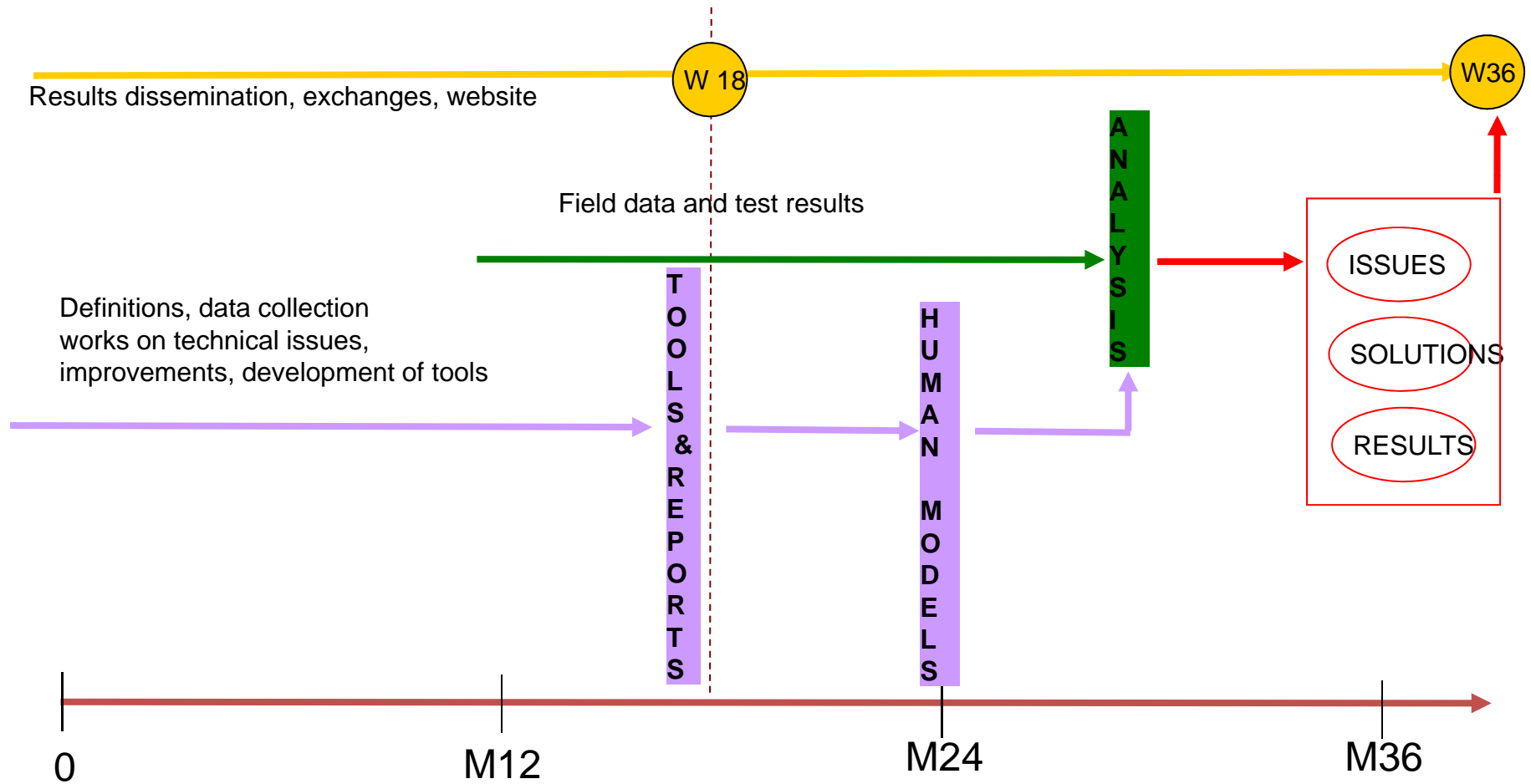
